After a long two years of planning and preparation the ACYOA Seniors successfully hosted the ACYOA General Assembly & National Sports Weekend this past Memorial Day Weekend.

The four day event started with the Annual General Assembly of the ACYOA. Over 100 delegates from all across the Diocese gathered for two days of meetings which were held in Tarvezian Hall. Annual business of the ACYOA was discussed and elections were held during the meetings. In addition, delegates and clergy were treated to a welcome reception at ALMA and a wonderful luncheon hosted by the Primate.

The National Sports Weekend events were all held in downtown Boston where over 430 participants were able to enjoy Boston's Historic Back Bay and the luxurious Copley Square Hotel. The Sports Weekend commenced on Friday evening with a kickoff event held at Kings Bowling and Billiards in Boston. On Saturday morning the Sporting Competitions began at Tansey Gym on the campus of Wentworth Institute of Technology. The Volleyball and Basketball Tournaments were conducted with a strong turnout with representation of teams from all over the diocese. St. James came out on top in Co-Ed Volleyball and finished as the runner-up for Men's Basketball. In addition, the Babayan Cup for overall Champion of the weekend was awarded to St. James at the Sunday evening event!

MESSAGE FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL CHAIRMAN

Update on Cultural Center and Church Renovations

The Charles Mosesian Cultural & Youth Center at St. James Armenian Church has undergone some significant renovations over the past 2 years. While you may not have noticed, because much of the work up to this point has not been readily visible to those entering the Center, over the next several months some of the more highly visible projects will be taking place.

Thanks to a generous 75th Anniversary Capital Campaign donation from Charles Mosesian, of blessed memory, and the generosity of our parishioners who contributed to our Capital Campaign, we have completed a number of building renovation projects, with several more in the planning stages. Completed projects include:

1. Complete renovation and updating of the building's heating and air conditioning system, which included two new boilers, new roof-top air conditioning units for Keljik Hall and new heating units for all the classrooms and offices, including computer based climate control systems.
2. Upgrade of the building's electrical system, and the repair of emergency lighting and other life safety systems.
3. Replacement of the ceiling in Keljik Hall (completed in connection with the new air conditioning system installation).
4. Replacement of our old rubber roof with a new state of the art composite roof and, after completion of this project, repair of areas with significant water damage that occurred over the years (including water-stained ceiling tiles in many of the classrooms and offices).
5. Work is underway with several interior renovation projects including new paint on the first floor of the Cultural Center, which should be completed in early fall. The moveable partition between Keljik Hall and Mirak Hall is also being repaired and resurfaced.

Future projects that are being planned include:

1. Replacement of carpeting and painting of the upper and lower classroom levels.

2. Renovation of the four restrooms at the Center. The first floor restrooms will receive a facelift with new paint, stalls, countertops, new carpeting (in the women's restroom), and state of the art and environmentally conscious features, including automatic flush valves and faucets. The lower level restrooms will also receive facelifts with more modest finishes and amenities.
3. Upgrading the sound system in Keljik Hall.
4. Updating window treatments and entrances.
5. Enhancing the existing landscaping surrounding the Center, to include outdoor lighting to enhance the appearance and visibility of the Center at night.

The Center's kitchen and grill area are also benefiting as a result of the 75th Anniversary Capital Campaign. Thanks to a generous donation from Dr. Gregory and Debbie Adamian, in honor of Harry Adamian, of blessed memory, the outdoor grill area has been renovated, including a new canopy roof and stainless steel canopy ceiling and walls with high speed exhaust fans, and new lighting. We are also in the planning stages of a significant kitchen renovation to include more secure storage of supplies and utensils, stainless steel countertops and possible replacement and reconfiguration of appliances.

Finally, those who have entered the sanctuary recently noticed the beautiful new wooden church doors, thanks to the generous donation of Charles and Joyce Guleserian to the 75th Anniversary Capital Campaign. Final installation steps are being implemented, and the doors will be dedicated in the Fall in a special service.

As always, if you have any questions or comments about any of the building renovations or anything else going on at the church, please speak directly with me or any other Parish Council member. Thank you all again to our parishioners who supported the 75th Anniversary Capital Campaign, whose support makes these renovations possible.

Membership & Stewardship

A Few Notes on Parish Membership

- All are welcome and encouraged to join us in worship each Sunday at Divine Liturgy, and all baptized are welcome to receive the sacrament of Holy Communion. You do not have to be a dues-paid member of the parish to worship at Saint James.
- While Membership in the parish is not a requirement, it is a wonderful way to commit to, and strengthen your relationship with, the members of your parish family and with God.
- Membership is an active and intentional commitment to be part of something larger than yourself, to be a part of the St. James family and the Armenian Church.
- Membership allows members also to participate in the formal life of the parish: participation and voting in the annual parish assembly, assuming leadership roles in the parish through elected positions.

What is the Difference between Stewardship and Membership?

- Stewardship involves returning to God the gifts that He has given us: gifts of time and talent, and monetary gifts.
- Stewardship is also the practice of caring for God's home here on earth – our St. James parish.
- We recognize that each of us has many competing demands for our money. We also recognize that many of us already financially support various groups and organizations. Usually we give more to those organizations that mean the most to us and have the greatest need. When we give to those people and organizations about which we care, our giving usually involves some measure of sacrifice. We hope that you will give generously to your parish family.
- The dollar amount you pledge is not as important as your pledge itself, and your giving in a way that is proportionate with your means and ability.

Did You Know?

- Our St. James parish receives no financial assistance from the Diocese. St. James pays an assessment to the Diocese each year, to help the Diocese achieve its ministry and mission. Parishes benefit from these Diocesan programs and services.
- St. James is funded by the financial contributions of our members. The more we receive in pledge income the better able we are to serve the needs of our community.
- We very much hope that all those who have decided to make St. James their parish home will take the active step to commit as members, as well as to share their gifts of stewardship: time, talent and treasure.

An Inside Glimpse:

2009 Actual Income – \$867,985

Through the active commitment of our members, the church received \$88,925 in membership dues – this represents only 10% of our annual income and covers only 10% of our annual expenses.

Through the support and gifts of our stewards, the church received \$57,615 in stewardship gifts/pledges – this represents only 6% of our annual income and covers only about 6% of our annual expenses.

The remainder of our income is covered by unpredictable sources, including In Lieu of Flowers, Facilities Rentals, Bingo, and Sunday plate offerings.

We ask all families who benefit from St. James – through Sunday School, ACYOA, and all of its organizations – to consider taking the active step and joining the members and stewards of St. James in support of our church.

November 1, 2010

Jesus – Son of God

Christ’s divinity: Jesus is human, but He is also God.

November 8, 2010

Jesus – The Last Adam

Contrasting the original Adam with Christ who is called The Last or New Adam.

November 15, 2010

Jesus – The Prophet

When the Bible refers to Jesus as The Prophet, is it saying He is able to predict the future or is it something much deeper?

November 22, 2010

Jesus – Our Redeemer

Explore redemption and how Christ has “purchased us” with His own blood or Life.

January 24, 2010

Jesus – Our Peace

Peace is not simply the absence of conflict but rather a virtue reflecting the character of God Himself.

January 31, 2010

Jesus – The Bread of Life

Jesus didn’t just say He would give us our daily bread, he said He IS the Bread of Life.

February 7, 2010

Jesus – God

Christ’s divinity: Jesus is human, but He is also God.

February 21, 2010

Jesus – The Sun of Righteousness

Explore what we mean in our hymns when we refer to Christ as “The Sun of Righteousness.”

February 28, 2010

Jesus – The Light Of The World

One of the great “I Am” statements in Scripture is in John’s Gospel where Jesus said “I Am the Light of the world” (John 8:12). Explore the word “light” and the significance of Christ’s claim.

March 7, 2010

Jesus – The Lamb of God

God commanded Abraham to sacrifice his son Isaac on the altar. Study this passage and contrast the meaning of the passages that refer to Jesus as “the Lamb.”

March 14, 2010

Jesus – The Good Shepherd

Jesus is the “Great Shepherd of the Sheep” (Hebrews 13:20), and states “I am the Good Shepherd” (John 10:11), but at the same time He is the “Lamb that was slain” (Revelation 5:12).

March 21, 2010

Jesus – The Way

Jesus said “I go and prepare a place for you but I will come back and I will take you with me.” He also talked about the “way” I am going but the disciples asked “how can we know the way?” Jesus then responded with those famous words, “I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life.” Explore the significance of Christ being “The Way.”

March 28, 2010

Jesus – The Truth

Jesus does not say He will show us Truth. He claims to BE Truth. He is full of Truth, full of Grace, and the very definition of Truth.

April 4, 2010

Jesus – The Life

What does life mean and how is Christ identified as THE life?

April 11, 2010

Jesus – The Resurrection

What does it mean to say that Jesus is “The Resurrection”? Study the significance of the Gospel as it relates to the Resurrection of Christ.

PASTORAL CARE: HOME AND HOSPITAL CLERGY VISITS

The clergy are always available and would like to visit homebound and hospitalized parishioners. If you or someone you know is ill or hospitalized and would like to be visited, please call the church office at (617) 923-8860. Please note: when asked about your religion at a hospital, patients

should list themselves as "Armenian Orthodox" or "Armenian" not "other."

REQUIEM SERVICE/HOKEHANKISD

Arrangements for Requiem Service, Altar Flowers and Candles should be made through the church office by Thursday at noon. In accordance with the canons of the Armenian Church, Requiem Services may not be performed on the five major feast days: Armenian Christmas, Easter, The Feast of the Transfiguration, The Feast of the Assumption of the Mother of God, and The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.

BAPTISMS AND CHRISMATIONS

All baptisms must be scheduled at least two months in advance by calling the church office. According to the Armenian Church canons, a Baptism may only be performed once in a person's lifetime, provided such Baptism has been performed in a Christian Church and in the name of the Holy Trinity. At least one of the godparents must be a member of the Armenian Apostolic Orthodox Church.

WEDDINGS

Parishioners should contact the church office at least eight months in advance. A couple must contact St. James to confirm the availability of the Pastor and sanctuary prior to making any other arrangements. All weddings must follow the Canons of the Armenian Apostolic Orthodox Church and the laws of Massachusetts. In accordance with Diocesan discipline mandated by the Primate, all Sacraments must be administered in the church sanctuary. The couple must meet with the Pastor at least once for pre-marital preparation and counseling. Weddings cannot be performed during Great Lent or Holy Week, or on the five major feast days: Armenian Christmas, Holy Easter, The Feast of the Transfiguration, The Feast of the Assumption of the Mother of God, and The Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross.

FUNERALS

Families should make arrangements with the funeral director of their choice, who will contact the church office to arrange the funeral service. Generally, St. James coordinates funerals with Bedrosian Funeral Home and Giragosian Funeral Home; both are located in Watertown and are familiar with our Church traditions. Funerals may not be performed on religious holidays, major feast days, Saturdays after 3:00 p.m., or on Sundays.
